一、國立臺灣大學（下稱本校）理學院（下稱本院）為加速國際化之腳步，鼓勵在學品學兼優之在校國際研究生，設置國立臺灣大學理學院補助國際研究生獎助學金（下稱本獎助學金），訂定國立臺灣大學理學院補助國際研究生獎助學金設置要點（下稱本要點）。

### 二、經費來源

本院高等教育深耕計畫經費或自籌收入經費。

### 三、申請資格

本院在學並具正式學籍之國際研究生，且未受本校申誡以上處分者：

（一）前一學年學業等第積分（學業 GPA）三點二（含）以上；入學未滿一學年者，以前一學期成績計。

（二）碩士班三年級以上、博士班四年級以上之在學生，若前一學年未修讀學分者，應至少提出下列一種於前一學年被接受之審核文件：

1. 經同儕審閱之期刊論文或專書章節。
2. 曾於國際會議進行口頭報告或演講之佐證文件。
3. 經國際會議論文集收錄之論文。

### 四、申請時間

依本院公告時間及規定辦理申請。

### 五、核給名額

本獎助學金每年核給名額以四名為原則，本院得視經費多寡予以調整；本院各系所亦得由校務基金自籌收入經費增加名額。

### 六、核給金額

每名受獎生每學期可獲得獎助學金金額以不超過當學期學雜費總額為上限。

### 七、核給期間及年限

（一）受獎生經遴選獲獎，受獎助期間為當年度九月至次年度八月。

（二）受獎生於受獎助期間如遇休學、退學或畢業時，本院即停發其獎助學金，

並得由候補學生依序遞補。

(三)同一受獎生受領本獎助學金之期限，碩士班至多二年，博士班至多三年。

(四)如有特殊個案，悉依本院國際事務委員會審查會議決議辦理。

#### 八、受獎助資格審核

(一)第一階段：由本院各系所初步審核申請生申請資格。

(二)第二階段：本院各系所將初審合格之申請生資料送交本院，由本院國際事務委員會審查委員(下稱審查委員)複審，審查委員就申請生之各項成績、進步情形或其他特殊表現為考量，排定受獎助資格之優先順序。

九、領取本獎助學金者，不得同時兼領本校或我國政府所提供之其他獎助學金。

十、本要點如有未盡事宜，悉依本校或教育部相關規定辦理。

十一、本要點經院務會議及行政會議通過後，自發布日施行。

#### I. Purpose

In order to accelerate the internationalization of the College and encourage academically outstanding international graduates of the University, the National Taiwan University College of Science (hereinafter referred to as "the College") has drafted the guidelines enclosed herein.

#### II. Sources of Funding

Dedicated International Operating Expenses under the Higher Education Sprout Project or Self-Funded Income in the National Taiwan University Fund.

#### III. Eligibility

International degree graduates of NTU who are officially registered and enrolled, have not received a written reprimand or more severe penalty from NTU as a result of misconduct, and have fulfilled one of the following criteria are eligible to apply:

1. Current students: Applicants must have achieved a GPA averaging 3.2 (inclusive) or above in the previous academic year. Students enrolled for less than one academic year: Applicants must have achieved the aforementioned average in the previous semester.
2. Students in the third year and above of the Master's degree and the fourth year of the doctoral degree and above who have not taken courses in the previous academic year must submit at least one of the following documents for evaluation:
  - a. Paper or book chapter published by a peer-reviewed journal/book.
  - b. Supporting documents of oral presentations or speeches at international conferences.
  - c. Conference proceeding papers.

#### IV. Application Timeline

Continuing international graduate students should apply to the College according to the published schedule and regulations.

#### V. Number of Awardees

In general, four awardees shall be selected per year, but this number shall be subject to change in accordance with annual finances.

Each department or institute may increase the number of awardees in accordance with their Self-Funded Income in the National Taiwan University Fund.

**VI. Amount Awarded**

Master's and Doctoral program students shall be granted no more than their Tuition and Miscellaneous Fees per semester.

**VII. Award Duration**

1. From September of the award year to the following August.
2. The scholarship should be terminated immediately after the awardees' suspension, withdrawal, or graduation from studies, and shall be awarded to the next student on the list of finalists.
3. The maximum length of time a student can receive the scholarship is two academic years for students in Master's programs and three academic years for students in doctoral programs.
4. For exceptional cases, the applications will be reviewed and determined by the College Review Committee.

**VIII. Application Review Process**

1. Phase One: The applicant's GPA and application materials will be first reviewed by each Department/Institute.
2. Phase Two: The approved application materials will be delivered to the College. The College Review Committee will rank applicants and determine awardees based upon criteria including grades, academic progress, and other indicators of outstanding performance.

**IX. Restriction on Scholarship Receiving**

Recipients of this Grant shall not receive any other scholarships or financial assistance grants sponsored by the University or the ROC government.

X. Matters not covered in the guidelines enclosed herein shall be handled in accordance with relevant regulations of the Ministry of Education and National Taiwan University.

XI. The guidelines enclosed herein shall be in effect on the announcement day following approval by the College Affairs Meeting and the University's Administrative Meeting.
